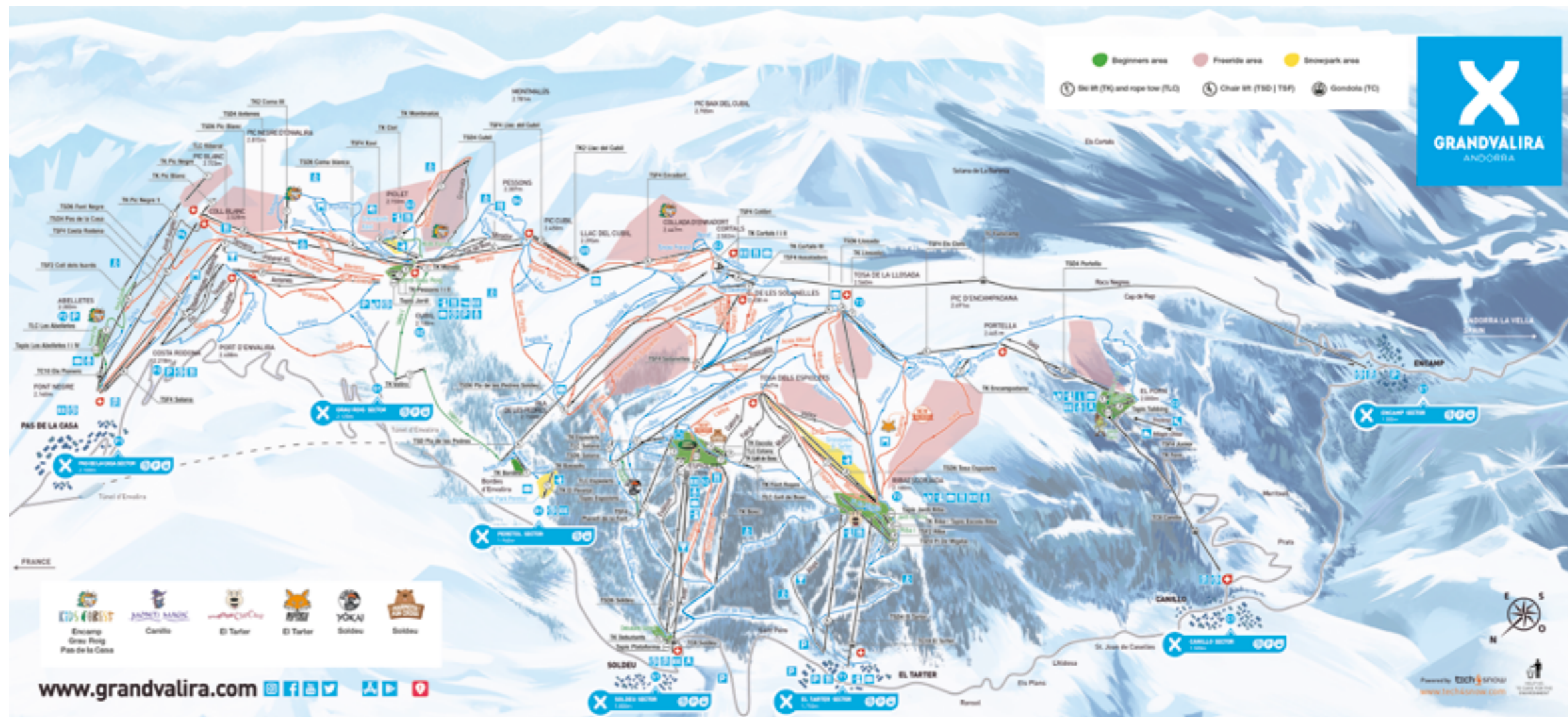

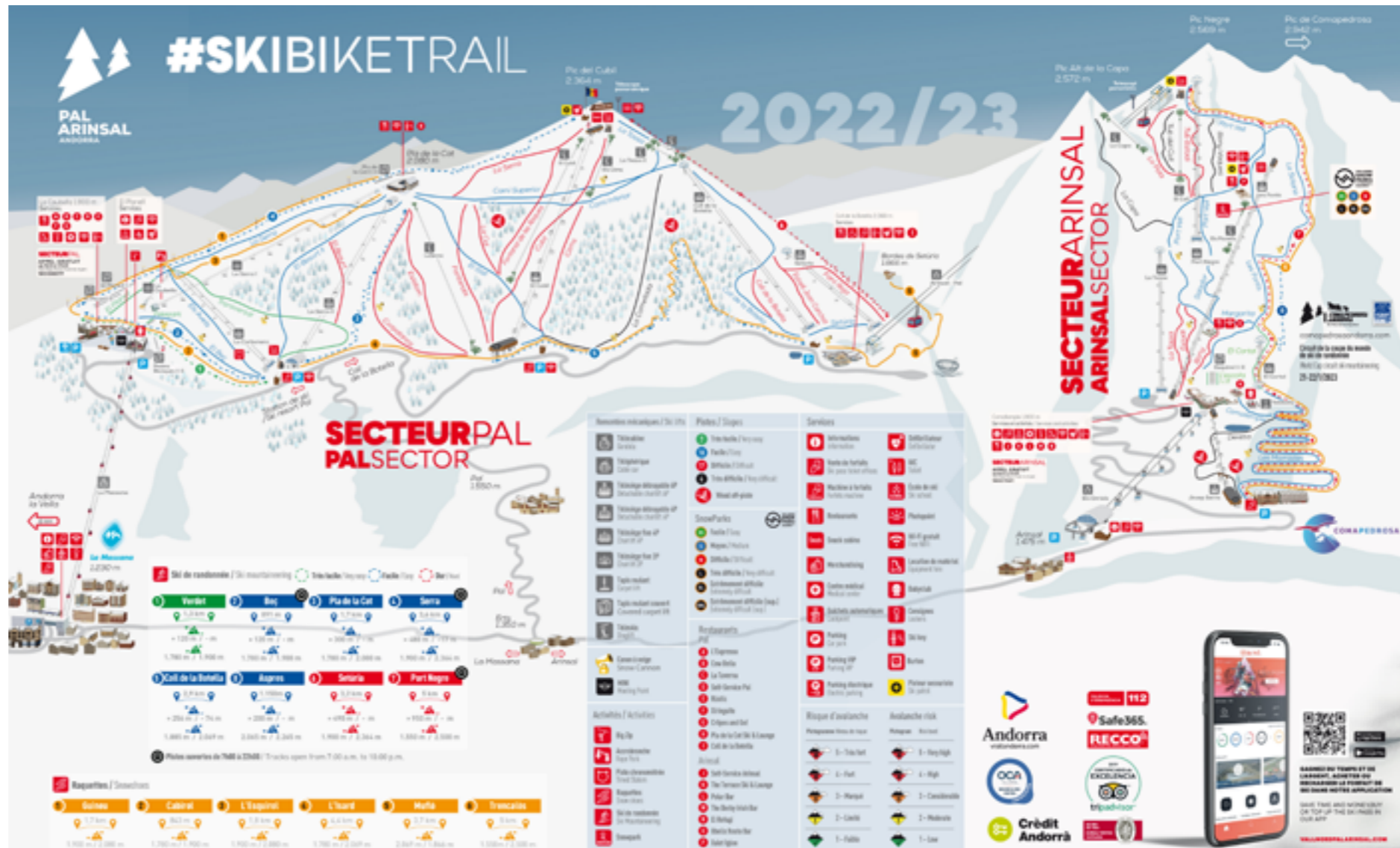

Cross-country skiing, activities and experiences in the snow!

■ Located in **Sant Julià de Lòria**, in the surroundings of **Naturland**, Naturlandia is an outdoor activities hotspot.

In La Rabassa, **you can practice cross-country skiing along more than 15 km of marked slopes at an altitude of 2,050 m.** In an incomparable setting, the station offers a large beginners area with 1.6 km of track. The rest of the tracks with different levels of difficulty circulate within the forest: 1.8 km of green track, 5.5 km of blue track and 6.5 km of red track for the experts.

It also has a **wide range of snow activities**, such as snowshoeing (which can be rented at the store and practiced on marked routes), guided snowmobile outings, new skimo routes. We also propose **nighttime activities** with exclusive guided outings on snowshoes or snowmobiles followed by an exquisite dinner at the La Conangle Borda mountain restaurant.

The offer is complemented by the **Tobotronc, the longest alpine toboggan in the world with a 5.3 km route** allowing you to discover the forest through a thrilling ride while sitting on an easy-to-use two-seater sled.

For example, you will find beautiful views, in the three protected, nature park and valleys: Les Valls del Comapedrosa Communal Natural Park, Sorteny Natural Park located in the parish of Ordino (declared as a biosphere reserve) and the Vall del Madriu-Perafita-Claror which has been declared a World Heritage by UNESCO.

During the summer months, Andorra offers a wide range of open-air activities, shows, live music in the streets and squares, traditional festivals, town festivals and so on.

■ In the **Canillo** area, the Magic Mountain Family Park is the ideal place to enjoy with family or friends: adrenaline, fun and a multitude of activities at an altitude of 2000 m! The 550 m-long zip line, the kayaks and canoes, the BigAirbag are just a part of the thrill. Take a ride on the Màgic Gliss mountain slide, through which you can also go down (with 3D glasses to enjoy a

virtual reality experience. Finally, the Explor Games®, activities that combine the dynamics of escape games with video games, complete the family experience in the Canillo sector and new this season are the Red Shark, which combines cycling and the aquatic world, and the QuickFlight, a 7m drop system.

■ In the **Soldeu** area, the highest



golf course in the entire Pyrenees awaits you at 2250 m above sea level. This 9-hole course, par 33, has a length of 2,590 m and an area of 16 hectares: perfect for beginners as we have a golf school to get started, and as well as for experts who will be able to enjoy playing golf with exceptional views. In Soldeu you can also enjoy the Marmot Observation Center, a fun activity

to learn more about the marmot, or go on outings with experienced beekeepers for bee resources.

■ **Encamp** sector has numerous activities for all the family. The Funicamp experience is a great gateway to the wealth and the history of the Pyrenean environment and countryside. In just 25 minutes, you come to an altitude of 2,502 m, where you can

enjoy diverse activities on foot as well as routes in a 4x4 bus and a guide. At the intermediate station of the Funicamp you can enjoy a stroll through the Els Cortals Valley, or go walking.

■ In the **Pessons** area of **Grau Roig** there are various activities, such as hiking, fishing and trips in 4 x 4 vehicles, while enjoying magnificent views. To finish off,

you can taste the best high-altitude cuisine in a unique setting.

ORDINO ARCALIS SUMMER

Ordino Arcalís, where times stands still

■ The main summer attraction in Ordino Arcalís is undoubtedly the spectacular Tristaina Solar Viewpoint. It is located on the Peyreguils peak at an altitude of 2,701 m and offers a 360-degree panoramic view of the Tristaina glacial cirque and the entire Ordino valley which was declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO. The Tristaina gondola and the Creussans chairlift provide easy access to the viewpoint with the last section done on foot. The structure, which has a 25-m-long walkway and a total weight of 32 tons, is integrated

into the environment with only four anchor points. In addition, the viewpoint acts as a sundial thanks to the 27-m-long central gnomon inclined at 42.55 degrees.

In Ordino Arcalís, you can also enjoy the unique ascent by bicycle to a final port of the Tour de France and La Vuelta a España free from road traffic, an experience for cycling lovers. This activity can be concluded with the excellent cuisine of the La Coma restaurant, newly renovated, at an altitude of 2,200 m.

From appetizers in the cable car, lunches at Pal station or astronomical dinners at the Coll de la Botella, Vallnord offers a variety of gastronomic selections. Pal Arinsal also offers a great variety in its 7 restaurants during the summer.

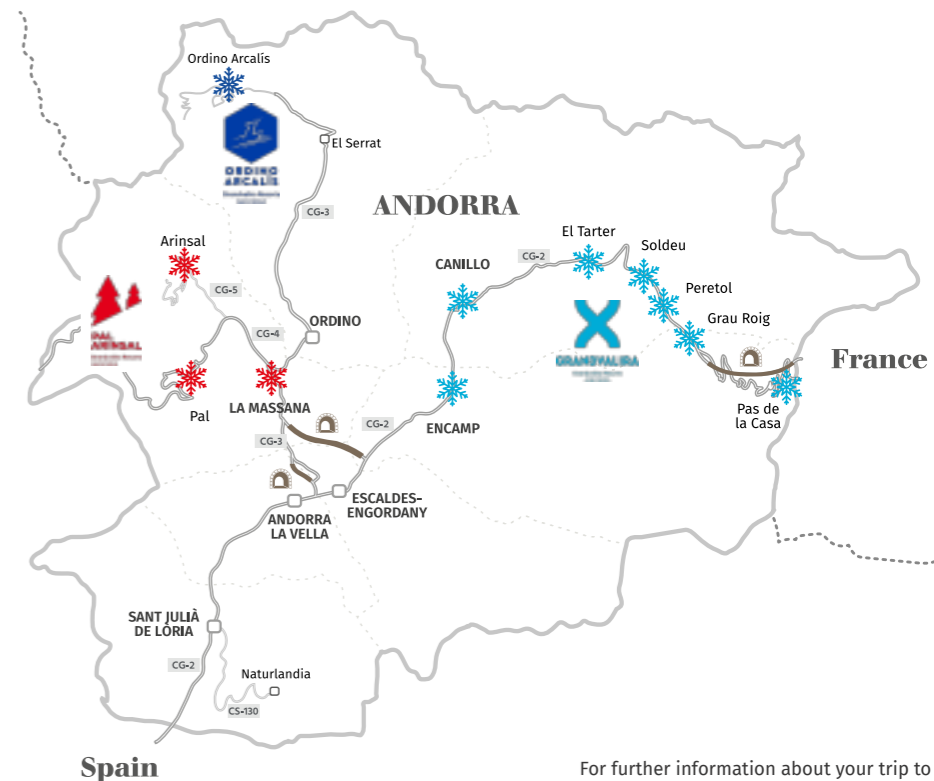
